
! DASHBOARD MODIFICATION REQUIRED !

Please note that some modification/cutting to the sub-dash plastics is required in order to fit an aftermarket head unit using this kit. Please refer to Step 5 for more information

INSTALLATION GUIDE



Use a panel removal tool to unclip the panel surrounding the small dash display. Remove the entire trim panel and place safely to one side for reassembly.



Remove the four screws highlighted by the arrows located above the OEM head unit.




Remove the OEM head unit and disconnect all wiring.


Dismount the air vents and mount them to the new fascia panel included with the kit.




Use a cutting tool to remove the middle bar (highlighted by the arrows in the image) to allow space for the new head unit to fit into the dashboard cavity.



Mount the left and right brackets to the head unit using the supplied hex screws.



Remove the OEM display and cut away the overlapping pins on the left and right as highlighted by the arrows in the image.




Mount the OEM display to the display panel by turning the panel upside down and placing the display as shown in the image.



Push the bottom of the OEM display until it snaps into place.



Fix the display into position using two supplied screws at the points highlighted by the arrows in the image.



Remove the five clips from the original fascia panel and replace them onto the new display panel as shown in the image.



Make all required wiring connections to the back of the aftermarket head unit and fit the head unit/fascia/display assembly into the dashboard cavity to complete the installation.
